Dear Atlas Families,

We have been notified by local public health officials and superintendents that there will be a one-week school closure of all El Paso County public schools beginning Monday, March 16. Schools will remain closed through Spring Break. The decision to re-open following Spring Break will be evaluated throughout this two-week period. We will continue to communicate updates as they come in.

Atlas is committed to meeting the essential needs of our students during this recess. We are actively working with our HSD2 partners in providing access to food/meal (breakfast and lunch) pick up for those in food insecure environments.

Atlas will be enforcing the travel guidelines established by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) for our schools for Spring Break travel. Anyone (student or student's family members or staff or staff's family members) that travel to a Level 2 or 3 country on CDC's website now or as updated, will be required to quarantine themselves for fourteen days after returning from travel or after contact with the traveling family member. We are responsible for the safety and well-being of students and staff while in our buildings and would not want to potentially expose anyone to this virus. We hope you understand our position and will provide your full cooperation with these protocols.
